BENEFIT OF THE PROPOSAL

This initiative will ultimately replace the different regulatory regimes that currently exist in the Member States, and will:



Eliminate barriers to market entry and reduce market delays



Reduce compliance costs, facilitate innovation, and improve competitiveness



Facilitate use of machinery across intra-EU borders



Ensure high and equal requirements for the road safety of non-road mobile machinery across the EU

DID YOU KNOW?

SMEs account for **98%** of all companies registered and contribute to **18%** of the sector's revenues and **30%** of the sector's employment

Only **4%** of the EU production is sold in the EU country where production takes place

42% of the EU production exported is to non-EU countries

54% of the EU production is traded intra-EU

The new rules will bring up to **€846 million** costs savings over a period of **10 years** for the sector
