About the Transition Pathway for Tourism

The <u>Transition Pathway for Tourism</u> was published on 4 February 2022. It identifies 27 areas for the green and digital transition of the EU tourism ecosystem, and for improving the sector's resilience. As part of the co-implementation process of the transition pathway, the European Commission published a call for commitments for public and private tourism stakeholders to commit to concrete actions.

The <u>2-year anniversary stakeholder event</u> aims to look at past achievements and future developments in the tourism ecosystem, showcase good examples of stakeholder commitments and pledges, and facilitate exchanges and engagement of the stakeholder community.
