## **1. PURPOSE OF THE DOCUMENT**

This document lists the responsibilities of providers of assistance and problem-solving services and network managers in relation to different actions that have to be undertaken in order to comply with the requirements of the Single digital gateway Regulation (SDGR) and its implementing act on user statistics and feedback, such as:

- ✓ User feedback tool
- ✓ Statistics
- ✓ SDG logo
- ✓ Single Market Obstacles tool
- ✓ Tagging of the websites
- ✓ Common assistance service finder

Nothing prevents national coordinators to delegate these tasks to the relevant service providers or to take on the tasks of service providers. That is why this checklist does not distinguish between the tasks of the service providers and the national coordinators as we consider that this is up to each Member State to decide.

This document also helps to identify the relevant technical specifications and guidelines prepared to help completing these tasks.

This check list complements the previous one that focuses on the quality requirements laid down in Article 11 and 16 of the SDGR, available on wiki ([Checklist for assistance services \(previous\)](#)).
