Rules and regulations



Integrity and originality

- Submissions must be the original work of the applicant(s) and free of plagiarism.
- Any evidence of plagiarism or fraudulent claims will result in immediate disqualification.

Confidentiality

- All entries will be treated confidentially, and proprietary information will not be shared without prior consent from participants.
- Judges and organisers will sign non-disclosure agreements (if requested) to protect the intellectual property of applicants.
- The top 10 finalists must sign a privacy notice to protect the confidentiality of the business ideas of other applicants.

Disqualification

- Entries failing to meet the eligibility or submission requirements will be disqualified.
- Failure to comply with competition rules may result in disqualification at any stage.

• Judges' decision

o The decision of the panel of judges will be final and cannot be appealed.

Participation fee

o Participation is free.

Pitch guidelines

- Pitches during the finals must not exceed 3 minutes.
- o Participants will have 3 minutes for a Q & A session with the judges.

Travel support

 The organisers will arrange and pay for the travel arrangements for the finalists to participate in the pitching event and award ceremony.

Prizes

- As the main prize, the 10 finalists will each receive tailored support through a pre-incubation/acceleration programme worth up to EUR 20 000, providing them with the resources and guidance needed to take their businesses to the next level.
- Following the pitching event and award ceremony, the top three applicants will get media coverage and promotional support, plus a free trip to the SME Assembly taking place in November 2025 in Denmark.
- o The winner will also receive a trophy.
