### Single Market Forum 2021 Closing Conference

25 June 2021

Lisbon, Portugal







The European Commission and the Portuguese Presidency team were delighted to receive more than 400 registrations to the Single Market Forum Closing Conference, which took place virtually as a Zoom meeting on 25 June 2021 from Lisbon, Portugal.

The Forum agenda covered discussions on how the Single Market was changed by COVID and how it will emerge. All industrial ecosystems have been affected by the pandemic, albeit in an asymmetric way. The Portuguese Presidency of the Council and the European Commission do their best to bring Europe's economy, in particular the SMEs, on the path of recovery and more resilience.

The event was structured in a plenary session, as well as a political panel for debating the topics mentioned above and two parallel workshops.
